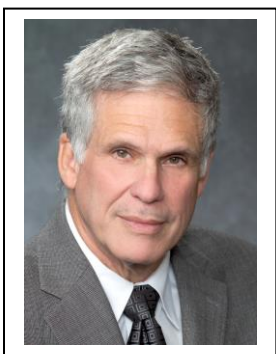

### *Community Outreach*

At Alliance Community Hospital our colleagues give back to the community in a variety of ways. We have a number of employees who dedicate their personal time to serve on several boards such as the Alliance Chamber of Commerce, YWCA, the Alliance Area Development, the Stuckey Interfaith Center, Safe Kids Stark County, the Stark County Health Needs Advisory Committee, the American Heart Association, the Prescription Assistance Network, and the Alzheimer Association among many others.

The hospital is a proud supporter of fundraising activities for the American Heart Association Go Red for Women as well as the Stark County Heart Walk. We hosted several fundraisers including the Stark County United Way and the Portage Lakes Dragon Boat Festival.

We continued to host our popular lecture luncheon series by hosting a different topic along with a complimentary lunch every month in our cafeteria conference room. Our Education Department hosted several events such as our sports symposiums teaching CPR, Diabetes education and outreach as well as smoking cessation classes. We participated in various health fairs throughout the community distributing literature and performing blood pressure screenings such as the annual Days in the Park event at Silver Park where we see over 200 Alliance residents during the 4 day festival. In September we hosted our second annual "Fall into Good Health" health fair. This health fair attracts nearly 400 attendees annually and offers free screenings, giveaways, health information and more.

### *Foundation report*

This past year the Alliance Community Hospital Foundation hosted several fundraising events. To kick off the year we hosted the annual “Steppin Out and Swinging with Hospice.” This annual event features a live and silent auction as well as local legends, Jimmy and the Soulblazers. This event helped us to raise over \$18,000 for our very own Alliance Hospice.

In 2017 we hosted our third Alliance Community Hospital Casino Night. On Friday April 23, the Alliance Country Club turned into our very own Caesars Palace, complete with black jack tables, roulette wheels and more! This event was a success raising \$16,000 towards a new bi-pap/c-pap units for our respiratory department.

In June we once again hosted our annual Charity Golf Classic. Funds raised at this event are graciously donated by the hospital to four non-profit agencies in the city. The Alliance Area Development, the Alliance Family Health Center, the Alliance Family YMCA and the Alliance for Children and Families each received a check for \$8,500.

In August the streets of Alliance were filled with walkers and runners as we hosted our 10<sup>th</sup> annual “Steppin Out for Hospice 5K.” Over 400 participants joined us for this annual twilight event. Supporters of all ages helped us raise over \$15,000 for Hospice program.
